1. The Thrive City String Boot Camp is in partnership with the Delta Community Music School, a not-for-profit organization.
2. Fees are payable in advance or at registration for the camp in full. Acceptable forms of payment are cheque, cash, or money order. Make cheques/money orders payable to "Delta Community Music School" or "DCMS." All NSF cheques will be charged a \$25.00 handling fee.
3. Enrolment into the camp is only final upon full payment of camp fees.
4. Once camp commences, refunds will be made only if the camp is canceled for any reason, or if an injury or serious family issue prevents the student from completing the camp. In case of injury or family issues, refunds will be prorated for the remaining day(s) of camp.
5. Non-attendance at lessons does not constitute withdrawal.
6. Due to the continuous nature of the camp, missed classes cannot be made up and if a child withdraws from the camp for any reason except those outlined above, fees will remain payable until the end of the session.
7. The Camp accepts no responsibility for personal injury occurring at any Camp activity (including transportation to and from the activity) nor for any damage to instruments or personal property, however caused.
